

Partnerships at SPGS

Over 130 secondary school students attended our Easter and Summer STEM revision programmes for GCSE and A Level revision, of which:

- 84% feel more confident about revising science.
- 88% now have a better understanding of the relevant science content.
- 80% now have a better understanding how to approach maths problems.
- 100% of A level students now have a better understanding of the content.
- 96% Y11 students and 88% Y13 students rated the revision courses as 4/5 or 5/5 for usefulness.

- Mentoring pupils in maths at Larmenier & Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School.
- Assisting pupils in literacy and numeracy at John Betts Primary School.
- Supporting Friday afternoon clubs at Parayhouse School, a specialist school for children with special needs and disabilities.
- Running activities at Two Hands Preschool.
- Undertaking a community gardening project at Holy Trinity Church in Barnes.
